MIGHAEL OLDHAM

AT THE INTERSECTION OF CONSERVATION OF BUILT HERITAGE AND LANDSCAPE ARCHITECTURE

Host: Sebastian Dobrusskin, Head of the Institute Materiality in Art and Culture

Guest: Michael Oldham is an award-winning landscape architect, artist, jeweller and writer. He studied at Plymouth Art College, Plymouth Polytechnic, and Sheffield University, and worked both in local government and private practice.

In his lecture Michael Oldham will present three projects, St.Edmunds Church (England), Barr Town Centre (France) and Stonehouse Peninsula (England), dealing with the relationship between landscape architecture and the preservation of architectural monuments. For example, changes in road networks or the changed meaning of a path both affect the position of a monument in its

surroundings and can thus have an impact on its access and perception.
