Richard Niessen (1972) & Esther de Vries (1974) describe their work as “lyrical design”: expressive and imaginative, using a rich language. Their work is involved, subjective and personal in content. It is spontaneous, even conversational, not intended to impress with its erudition or cleverness.

Being graphic designers doesn't limit them to two dimensions or sole print work: their designs range from exhibitions to textiles and from ceramics to coins, always highly “compressed” allowing to “unpack” the meaning. They work for clients like artists Jennifer Tee and Auke de Vries, cultural institutions like Stedelijk Museum Amsterdam and Fonds BKVB, companies as Maharam and Dell. They also initiate a lot of their projects themselves, like “1:1:1” and “Op basis van Bas Oudt”. Their exhibition “TM-City” gives an overview about their work. It was shown in Chaumont, Amsterdam, Sofia and other cities.
