You Contain More Than Culture

Practicing Care as an Inter-cultural Practice through Taste

What can we learn about the world through the specific metabolic entanglements that we engage in through eating? What are the forms of relationality that we can notice through a practice that uses food, and how might these create practices of critical care that can inform eco-social futures where we can all (human and otherwise) thrive?

In this lecture, multidisciplinary artist and researcher Kaajal Modi (she/they) will discuss some projects they have worked on to date to do with food, culture and care as critical practices. Starting with a social design practice in Glasgow, through their work in grassroots activism with Food Not Bombs in North London, through artistic interventions in South London, they discuss how food has formed the basis of their work, and the particular affordances of eating as an eco-social practice. They will also discuss their present speculative collaborative practice that forms the basis of their present

PhD research, using fermentation (and other preservation practices) with migrant women of colour as a way to explore bio-relationality as a poetic metaphor through which to understand interdependence.
