## Master of Arts in Specialized Music Performance

Major: Chamber Music

### Practical test (Classical)

The aptitude test takes place on the basis of a video recording that you can upload for our university. The information on the technical requirements for the videos can be found on our website.

About two weeks before you will have your interview, you will receive precise information about the time slot on your exam day during which you have to be ready. Just before the meeting starts you will receive a zoom link by email.

### Content

- Preparation of 4 complete, demanding pieces of various styles for the exam. Part of your program should be performed by heart.

- Interview about your professional goals and ideas. The conversation (individual interview) serves for self-reflection and clarifies the goals and framework conditions of the course. The personal interview will be conducted in German, French or English.
- We expect an exceptional artistic and technical ability from the applying formation. On the basis of the artistic dossier which has to be submitted, the formation must be able to demonstrate an in-depth examination of a most varied repertoire.

### Language skills

Understanding the German or French language is a requirement to study at the BUA. For more information, see the information sheet about language skills.

### Fees

The examination fee has to be payed before the aptitude test. Otherwise you can't take part at the examination.
