



Information on the aptitude test at the Bern University of the Arts

Master of Arts in Specialized Music Performance

Major: Solist

Practical test (Classical)

The aptitude test takes place on the basis of a video recording that you can upload for our university.

The information on the technical requirements for the videos can be found on our website.

About two weeks before you will have your interview, you will receive precise information about the time slot on your exam day during which you have to be ready. Just before the meeting starts you will receive a zoom link by email.

Content

- Preparation of **6 demanding pieces** (whole works or movements thereof) from **different periods** of your choice. Part of your program should be performed by heart.
- Interview about your professional goals and ideas. The conversation (individual interview) serves for self-reflection and clarifies the goals and framework conditions of the course. The personal interview will be conducted in German, French or English.

In addition, 3-4 weeks before your exam day (interview), the candidates will receive a mandatory piece, which has to be prepared and played.

As soon as we are in possession of these two documents, we can send you your mandatory piece.

Piano Accompaniment

Apart from solo works, it is expected that the works you play will be recorded with accompaniment.

Language skills

Understanding the German or French language is a requirement to study at the BUA.
